Parking Lot—Dismissal changes

Several close calls of cars and obstacles being hit in our parking lot have prompted some careful observation, and much discussion among our staff and faculty. The children's safety is our first and foremost concern, and we ask for your cooperation, patience, understanding as well as your dedication to making our morning arrival and afternoon dismissal safe for all.

We ask that when you enter the parking lot you park directly beside the cars already parked, or directly behind the car parked in front of you. When too many cars park in one line, it can obstruct the view of stationary obstacles or other cars increasing the chances of an accident. This is especially true of the first two rows closest to the rectory. A clear line of sight needs to be maintained between rows of cars for children to walk.

NO car is allowed to leave the parking lot until all the schoolchildren are in their cars and the signal is given for dismissal to begin. NO child is allowed to get out of their car and re-enter the parking lot once they have entered their car. If you have someone else picking up your child, please make them aware of the dismissal procedures that NO CARS or CHILDREN are to move until the signal is given. We will be alternating which direction we dismiss the cars from each day in hopes that parents will pay more attention to how they park in the lot. Often times we are in too much of a hurry to exit the parking lot or are talking on cell phones and not paying attention to dismissal. We are pleading with our adult and teen drivers who

are picking up to make sure all parking lot procedures are followed for the safety of our children. A reminder that if a staff person is not outside for morning dismissal downstairs, you can not let your child out as all the doors are locked from the outside and they cannot get in the building. Please bring them around to the front door. Thank you for your cooperation.

Lunch Program

We have had a very dedicated group of lunch volunteers this year, and we thank you for your dependability and dedication. We hope the second semester of the school year will be as full of volunteers as the first semester. We will be losing our lunch coordinator and cook, Gail Lessner, at the end of this year. Mrs. Lessner's daughter will be graduating and moving onto high school. If you are interested in taking this volunteer position, so that we can continue our lunch program in a similar fashion for next year, please contact Mrs. Caniglia.

Parents must transport the rocking chair to and from the event.

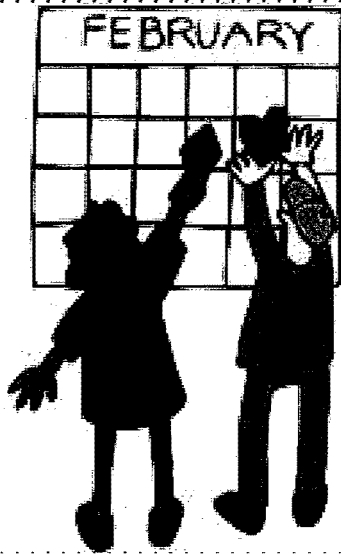
