In earlier discussions with Rene's owner, John Oyala, the expected time frame for this activity would not occur until early 2012. 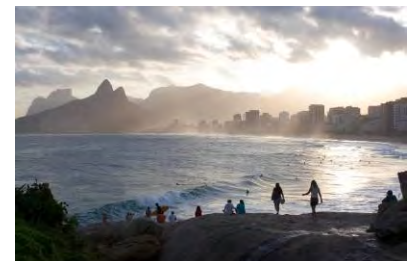

EARTHQUAKE STORIES—WHERE WERE YOU?

I'm collecting member stories about what they experienced in the unusual Virginia earthquake (the first one in over 100 years) in August. Please share your experiences and submit your stories to me, Liz, at sarejan5@yahoo.com as it will be fun to share. I have one story below:

From Denny Koski:

"Liz, It's a good thing that you're doing this because some people didn't feel what my neighbors and I felt. We experienced 30 to 45 seconds of what first sounded like a jumbo jet flying just feet above our houses about to crash on us. When the jumbo jet didn't crash, I thought it was some freak weather pattern, like a tornado. Our houses shook, things fell from shelves and other surfaces, and windows looked like they were gonna explode. Not one second did I think that it was an earthquake until it was all over. I had just got home from shopping about 10 minutes earlier. Other people that I talked to that were not that far from us had a far less violent experience. Very strange. For me, it was extremely scary. Had to go change my shorts soon after...only kidding. I couldn't believe that, after very carefully looking for structural damage, not a single crack could be found inside or out. Amazing!"

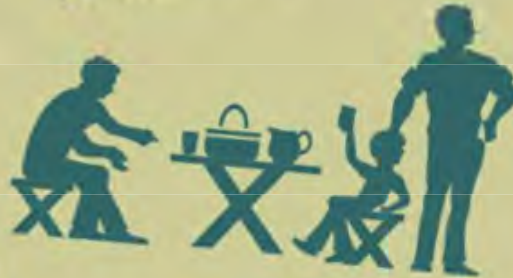
